» Continuous feedback is part of the foundation of agile delivery.

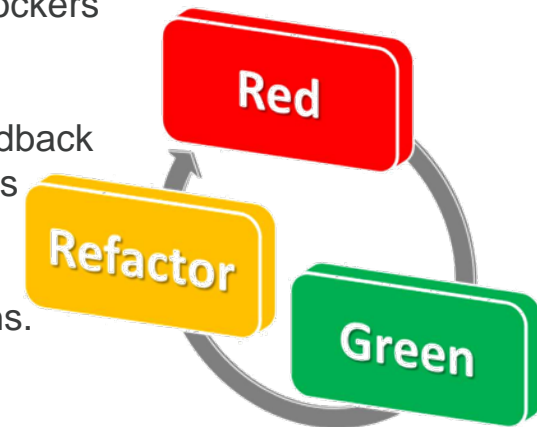
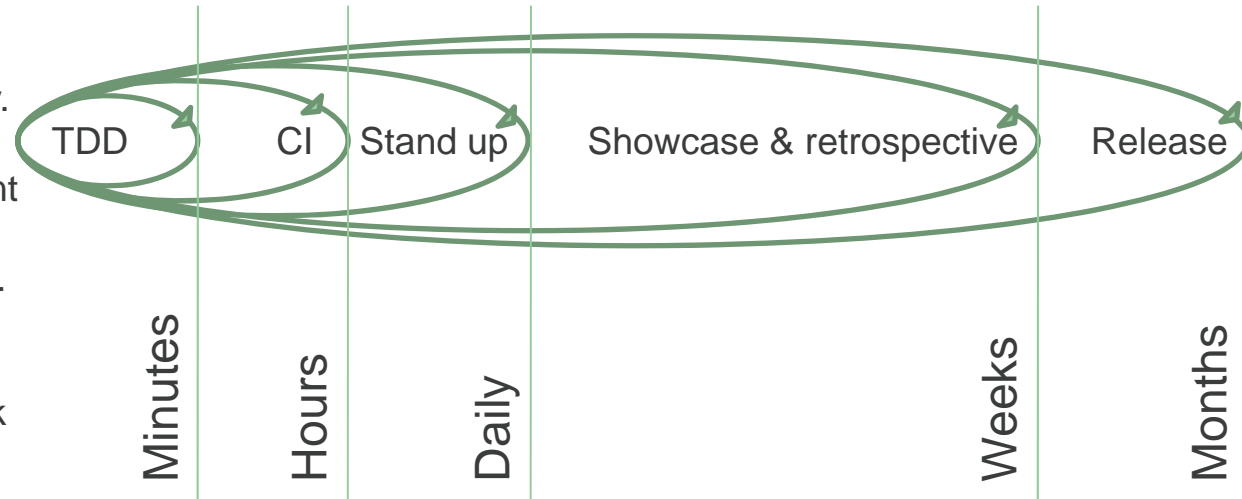
» Using Test Driven Development gives feedback on implementation within minutes.

» Continuous integration practices should give feedback on integration hourly.

» Daily stand ups allow team and customer to respond to the feedback on blockers and changes in plan.

» Iterations with showcases and retrospectives create the opportunity for feedback from the customer every few weeks validating priorities and correcting plans for changes in direction and practices.

» Releases give feedback from the broadest customer base every few months.



**Regular cycles of gathering and assessing information during a project help to reduce defects, avoid rework and major changes in direction, and add to the sense of achievement.**
