» Agile teams deliver their solutions in frequent small releases. This is one of the principles that is part of the Agile Manifesto

Our highest priority is to satisfy the customer through early and continuous delivery of valuable software.

» The benefits of Frequent Small Releases are:

- Early return on investment pay off
- Helps the customer focus on value instead time as features that don't go in this release can go in the next one
- Provides valuable feedback to help with prioritisation of subsequent features.
- Less impact on users of the solution due to incremental changes rather than big-bang changes
- Making the team think about simplicity for implementation
- Understanding of what it means to be truly "done"

At the end of every iteration you will have tested, working, production ready software to demonstrate to your customers. The decision to put it into production is theirs.
